Doctor 1 (IV access, breathing & procedures)



Preparation

- Self (Personal Protective Equipment appropriate for patient presentation)
- Prepare Equipment for IV access
- Prepare Equipment for any procedures deemed very likely pre arrival (e.g. ICC, IO equipment...)

Role – IV access, breathing assessment, assist / perform procedures

- Gain / confirm IV access on arrival
- Assess patient breathing for flail chest, pneumothorax, haemothorax and open wound; communicate findings with team leader
- Assist with preparation and performing procedures as directed by Medical Team Leader
- Assist in ordering of appropriate investigations as determined by the Medical Team Leader
- Rotate through CPR if required
- · Stand down from the team when directed
