



SCGH HOT Clinic

Advice to patients

The Doctors who reviewed you in the Emergency Department, do not think that you need admission, but you need to be seen by a General Surgeon. Please bring an overnight bag in case you are admitted.

A review by your General Practitioner is not adequate.

If you feel your symptoms are getting worse do not wait until your appointment, but return to the Emergency Department at SCGH. Explain to the reception staff you are re-attending now, as your symptoms are now worse.

Please follow these instructions:

1. You are still required to attend the Hot Clinic, even if your symptoms have improved.
2. Fasting Instructions:
No food from _____hrs. No drink/fluids from _____hrs.
Fasting includes lollies and gum.
3. You should attend the Hot Clinic at _____hrs.
4. The review clinic is in G Block Ward G61.
 - a. If entering from Hospital Avenue, take the green lifts to the 6th floor and follow the signs to Ward G61, ward clerks' reception desk and report in. They will direct you to the hot clinic.
 - b. If you are coming by the blue lifts, go to the 6th floor, and follow the signs to Ward G61.
5. Most patients will be able to go home after review. A few will need to be admitted. If you are admitted, you will be required to stay and not leave the hospital.
6. If you require follow up, this will be arranged with your GP or the outpatient clinic.
7. *If you are discharged but feel your symptoms returning, please come back to the Emergency Department at SCGH.*
