COVID-19 Checklist

Theatre Preparation

Prepare Anaesthetic Room Collect 'micro alert' trolley and PPE, ensure orange long-cuff gloves are available
Set up donning station with donning checklist
Ensure spare disposable hats available
Collect COVID resource box from theatre front desk
Prepare all airway, cannulation and invasive monitoring equipment
Prepare basic drugs and airway trolleys to be used for intubation in theatre
Ensure drug and airway trolley remains in anaesthetic room
Ensure waste bin present adjacent to sink for doffing N95 mask
Consider the use of baby monitors – available in tech storeroom
Prepare Operating Theatre
Place COVID-19 signs on all theatre doors
Remove all unnecessary equipment from theatre
Take the COVID kit from front reception for set up
Prepare anaesthesia machine, equipment and video-laryngoscope
 Standard equipment checks
 Remove all contents from anaesthetic machine drawers
 Cover anaesthesia machine, syringe drivers and video-laryngoscope with clear plastic (including
ultrasound as necessary)
Position clinical waste bin near hand sanitiser and put up doffing cheat sheet
Position all equipment for use including drugs and COVID airway trolleys
Prepare all patient positioning equipment in theatre
Dirty tray for used video-laryngoscope blade and other soiled equipment
COVID intubation checklist available
Ensure disposable pen set up at computer station for patient notes
Dropano Staff
Prepare Staff Team Huddle including patient positioning and any goals of care
Confirm all surgical and anaesthesia equipment requirements
Communicate clear airway and emergency plans including difficult airway trolley, defibrillator and who
will attend emergencies
Discuss means of communication between dirty and clean room (baby monitors/whiteboard)
Location of all staff at induction and extubation:
 Theatre – anaesthetist, intubating technician, scout nurse
 Anaesthetic room – 2nd assistant - technician (anaesthetist if available)
 Corridor – runner (technician or 3rd nurse) if available
Empty all pockets
Theatre nurse donned in PPE collects patient with HSA when ward ready
Communicate which essential staff required in theatre during induction and extubation
Inform TSSU and PACU – whole team understands plan
Confirm cleaning, waste and dirty linen processes
Remember to double glove
Prepare Transfer Communicate to ward nurse regarding nation transfer
