

# Frail Rapid Access Clinic – Referral Tips

## What Kind of Medical Issues Can We Manage?

Let us help you get your patients home. We see patients within 1 day to 1 week of referral, depending on need. We can manage patients with:

- Risk of re-presentation to hospital due to geriatric syndromes (Falls, Cognitive Impairment, Pain)
- Cellulitis/UTI on oral antibiotics
- Mild delirium
- Vertebral fractures/pain (not needing orthopaedic input/ brace)
- Leg oedema/mild heart failure for titration of diuretics
- Postural hypotension
- New medications with need for monitoring of response and side effects

### Criteria

Aged 65+, Reside in SCGH Catchment, Not currently admitted for COVID illness

#### **Services**

Rapid Access Clinic (Location: TT Block) - Geriatrician Clinic Daily

Telehealth and / or Phone Assessment

Allied Health Home Visits (as required)
