



## EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT DISCHARGE CHECKLIST

So you are discharging someone with COVID-19. Have you considered:

- Risk assess for adjunct treatments
  - See disease modifying treatments poster
  - Contact and fax / email prescription to patient's pharmacy for home delivery
  - D/w ID if needs Sotrovimab in ED
- Mandatory notification
  - Email notification form + d/c letter to [ncovcontact@health.wa.gov.au](mailto:ncovcontact@health.wa.gov.au)
- COVID Care @ Home (CC@H) referral indicated?
  - See ED COVID-19 Disposition pathway
  - Email discharge letter to [escalations@covidcareathome.com.au](mailto:escalations@covidcareathome.com.au)
  - Clinical care is then handed over to CC@H
- Transport options
  - Home
    - Ideally own transport
    - SCGH Patient transport 0930-1830 Mon-Fri; 1000-1600 Weekends.
    - Black & White taxi service as a last resort
      - Discuss with Nursing Shift Coordinator/ AHNM for special pin number
    - In State Quarantine
      - Inform SHICC on 9222 2017
    - Homeless
      - Call PHEOC on 1300 316 555
      - They will speak to patient directly
    - Residential Aged Care Facility
      - Expectation will be that they return home
      - Notify Residential Care Line on 64573146
- Give Written Patient Advice sheet (available on intranet)
- Extra support- does your patient need any of the following? (*work in progress*)
  - Social work referral
  - CCT2 Home Service
    - 7 day cover, refer by calling 6457 3609 or email [SCGH.CCT2Home@health.wa.gov.au](mailto:SCGH.CCT2Home@health.wa.gov.au) – there is no age or diagnosis restrictions
